INCLUDED IN PRICE: Round Trip Airfare from Chicago, Deluxe Motorcoaches, First Class / Superior First Class Hotels, Guided sightseeing, Entrance fees to sites visited, Breakfast & Dinner daily. A total of **\$520 USD** taxes comprised of fuel charges of **\$189.60** (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and taxes of **\$330.40**. These taxes include Federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person. Also included are gratuities of **\$130.00** to your tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew, gratuities on ferries, trains, and cruise ships.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Not included in your package are port taxes; passports; visas and vaccinations; laundry; telephone; mini-bar; alcohol, beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, ship, or restaurant); optional excursions; airport transfers on non-qualifying flights; portage at airports and train stations; Group Travel Protection premiums; excess baggage fees; and all other items not specifically mentioned. Any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines or cruise lines after the date you register for your trip.

PAYMENT: A full deposit of **\$500 per person is required at time of registration**. Final payment for trip must be made in the form of a check (credit cards are not accepted for final payment), including optional group insurance premium if applicable, is due no later than **90-days prior to departure**. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$95 will be assessed. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers for prices to be valid.

If group size is less than 20 a supplement to price will apply. **Imagine** reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While **Imagine** will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or if you request a single room, you will be charged for a **single room: \$660** for basic itinerary.

ITINERARY and CHANGES: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, **Imagine** reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$175 per night/per person; single rooms \$215 per night. Meals for extra night are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to

Imagine Tours & Travel no later than 70-days prior to departure. All tours are finalized at 60-days prior to departure and there are no changes or additions to the tour after that time.

AIRLINE TICKETS: In order to keep prices low, **Imagine** does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once printed, airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. **Imagine** is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept as partial payment for air transportation.

VISAS: Applicable visas will be obtained by **Imagine** for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. 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DAY 01 - OCT 22 - MON: DEPART USA

Tour members meet in Chicago for our flight to Israel. After dinner is served, sit back and relax, enjoying the on-board entertainment as you prepare for this exciting adventure of a lifetime - walking where Jesus walked. After a brief touchdown and change of planes, we continue for modern Israel, and the incomparable Land of the Bible.

DAY 02 - OCT 23 - TUES: ARRIVE TEL AVIV

In Tel Aviv we are met by our agent who assists us through customs and security. We transfer to our motorcoach for a short drive to our hotel in the Tel Aviv - Netanya area for our welcome dinner and overnight beside the beautiful Mediterranean Sea.

DAY 03 - OCT 24- WED: CAESAREA, MT. CARMEL, DRUZE VILLAGE, MEGIDDO, GALILEE

Today following breakfast it is on to Caesarea by the Sea. This ancient seaport, built in honor of Caesar Augustus by Herod the Great, was the Roman capital in the Holy Land for nearly 500 years. We view the majestic ruins of this great site and the nearby Roman aqueduct. Proceed on our drive through the Carmel mountain range, stop to see the beautiful gardens of the Bahai Temple, continue to the place where Elijah fought the prophets of Baal. (1 Kings 18:1 - 40). We stop for lunch before arriving at the ruins of Megiddo, one of Joshua's victories dating back to 4,000 B.C. Late afternoon we arrive at Mt. Arbel for the magnificent view from the top of the Sea of Galilee. Tonight dinner at our home for the next three nights.

DAY 04 - OCT 25 - THURS: GALILEE, TABGHA, MT. OF BEATITUDES, CAPERNAUM, BOAT RIDE, BETHSAIDA, JORDAN RIVER

There is nothing like watching a sunrise on the Sea of Galilee from our hotel. Today we make our way to Tabgha, Primacy of Peter, and the Mt. of Beatitudes (Matthew 5-7), with time for reflection and worship. We make our way to Capernaum (Jesus' base for His early ministry.), then board a replica wooden "Jesus Boat" for our boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We will also have an opportunity to see the recently excavated boat from the time of Jesus. Our lunch stop includes the option of the special St. Peter's Fish for those interested (not included). Afterwards we see Gadara and if time permits we'll include a short visit to Bethsaida, before we make our way to the River Jordan, where our day will conclude with a

memorable optional baptism at Yardenit. Return to our accommodations for dinner and overnight.

DAY 05 - OCT 26 - FRI: GOLAN HEIGHTS, CAESAREA PHILIPPI, TEL DAN, CANA, NAZARETH - GALILEE

After breakfast we drive to the city of the boyhood of Christ, Nazareth, a stop at the Mt. of Precipitation. Time permitting we will stop along the way at Cana where Jesus performed his first miracle at a wedding reception. There will be an opportunity to renew marriage vows for those that wish to do so. We proceed to visit the Church of Annunciation & Mary's well. Arriving at the Nazareth Village. It is here we'll be taken back to the life that was during the time of Jesus. From here we travel for the Golan Heights and view the area from a special lookout. We drive to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made the good confession of Christ as "the Son of the living God." (Matthew 16:13-16.). We will have a short hike/walk to Tel Dan where we will see the altar of Jeroboam and then a short drive takes us to Gideon Springs. Our long day will end with dinner and overnight.

DAY 06 - OCT 27 - SAT: GALILEE - BEIT SHEAN, JERICHO, QUMRAN, DEAD SEA

Departing the Galilee we drive south along the Jordan Valley to Beit Shean, a city dating back to the Canaanites, with eighteen layers of civilization where Saul and his sons were nailed to the city wall (1 Sam 31: 10). A short drive will bring us to the Jericho junction. The ancient city where the wall came tumbling down. Proceed on to Qumran, the possible settlement of the first century people known as the Essenes, authors of the Dead Sea Scrolls. We end the day as we check into our hotel on the Dead Sea. For those that wish to try and float in the famous salty waters and perhaps a mud rub, which would be a highly suggested experience before our dinner.

DAY 07 - OCT 28 - SUN: DEAD SEA, EIN GEDI, MASSADA, ARAD, BEERSHEBA, JERUSALEM

We begin the day with Ein Gedi where David hid from King Saul, walk up the path with its amazing waterfalls and a chance to see a few gazelles as they roam freely on the top of the mountains. Continue to the next stop of Massada, where we will ascend high upon the wilderness by way of the cable car to the fortress built by King Herod. Here we survey the ruins of the fortification, waterworks, synagogue, temples and palaces. It is here that Jewish zealots made their last stand against

the Romans in AD 73. We proceed driving south through the Rift Valley and connect with the highway heading to Beersheba. Here we visit the well and the Gate Structure. We then drive to the city of Lachish which was conquered by the Assyrians. We see here where the famous "Lachish Letters" were discovered. Driving on through the Shephelah (lowlands,) it's on to the city of Beit Shemesh for a brief stop. It is where the Ark of the Covenant was returned (1 Sam. 6) Next, we travel to the Elah Valley where David fought Goliath and re-enact the scene in our imaginations as we listen to I Samuel 17. Heading up the historic Beth Horon Road to the Benjamin Plateau, passing ancient Gideon and arriving to the majestic city of Jerusalem in time for dinner and overnight.

"I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem." (Psalm 122:1-2 NASB)

DAY 08 - OCT 29 - MON: MT. OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, JEWISH QUARTER, TEMPLE TREASURES, BETHLEHEM

We begin the day on the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage will proceed down the Old Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove, and the Church of Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We will visit the house of Caiaphas, where Jesus was condemned by the Sanhedrin and lowered into a dungeon. Passing through the Zion Gate, we enter the Jewish Quarter stop for lunch on our own, time to browse through the unique shops at the Cardo, Hezekiah's Wall (one of the most significant finds from the OT period is the Broad Wall, built by Hezekiah in the days before the 701 B.C. invasion. We will visit the Temple Treasures to view artifacts for building the next Temple. Drive to Bethany, a town on the eastern slope of the Mount of Olives. Here Jesus often visited Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. A village church reminds us of the resurrection of Lazarus (John 11:1-44). From here proceed to Bethlehem to visit the Shepherd's Fields and visit the Church of the Nativity. Time to shop before we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 09 - OCT 30 - TUES: JERUSALEM

We will enter Jerusalem through the Zion Gate, and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western (Wailing) Wall of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35 acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel. 24:18-25). On this site now stands EL-

Aksa Mosque, and the magnificent Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in Islam). From the temple area, we make our way to St. Stephen's Gate, to walk the Via Dolorosa - including St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Pavement (where Jesus stood while being tried by Pilate), Ecce Homo Arch, and the ancient Cardo. We continue to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. A short walk takes us to stand on the original steps that Jesus walked on as he entered the Temple area. We end the day with a drive to see the scale model of the city from Jesus' time, and the Shrine of the Book, where parts of the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. Return for dinner and overnight.

DAY 10 - OCT 31 - WED: JERUSALEM

After breakfast, we start the day by entering the Old City through the dung Gate. We walk 400 yards to the Western Wall Tunnel along the retaining wall of the Temple Mount itself. Walk up to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest site. Visit the southern wall excavations and then to visit the City of David and the new excavations of David's palace. Those who want to will then take an optional adventurous walk through the waters of Hezekiah's Tunnel (1, 720 feet long.) We will then sit on the steps of the Siloam Pool and listen to the story of John 9.

DAY 11 - NOV 1- FRI: JERUSALEM - TEL AVIV - HOME

Morning is a time of leisure, enjoy breakfast, pack and prepare for our afternoon departure trip to the Garden Tomb, where we will reflect on the sacrifice of Jesus through a time of communion. Your tour guide will have suggested things to do on this last day. Special farewell dinner tonight at the Ambassador Hotel.

DAY 12 - NOV 2- SAT: TEL AVIV - ARRIVE BACK HOME

We bid farewell to Jerusalem as we transfer to the airport very early this morning. The close of an unforgettable tour, we take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith as we arrive back in Chicago.
